Dress code for Boys

Trousers and collared shirt; shoes and socks and to be neatly shaved with clean white College apron with college emblem and name plates in the campus.

For Girls

Salwar Kameez, formal foot wear, hair to be tied; with clean white College apron with college emblem and name plates in the campus.

Prohibited for Boys

T- Shirts/shorts, tight-fitting jeans, corduroy pants, caps, chappals, sports shoes, ear-studs, torn trousers, pony tails, trousers with 6 or more pockets, body piercing and tattoos.

Prohibited for Girls

Tight-fitting leggings, jeans, corduroy pants, skirts, shorts, revealing deep tops, spaghetti top, sleeveless tops, shirts, T-shirts, dangling earrings, make-up, long nails, body piercing and tattoos.

To respect the sanctity of the pharmacy profession the students should not wear College aprons outside the college campus.
